Why drive? The trolley connects you to hundreds of great restaurants, shops, hotels, galleries, attractions, sporting events, and more!

It's all on the line, from the Pinch District, to Beale Street, the South Main Arts District, the FedEx Forum, AutoZone Park, the Riverfront and more.

The Madison Avenue Line connects downtown to the Medical Center, giving riders access to Midtown and medical facilities.

So step right up, drop in your fare and off you go. The trolley is the fun way to get around.



Be Smart, Be Safe

- 1 Always Stop, Look and Listen. Obey all warning devices: flashing lights, whistles, signals and crossings.
- 2 Keep your head, hands and body inside the trolley. Operator must assist if windows need to be raised or lowered.
- 3 Cross only at designated crossings.
- 4 LOOK BOTH WAYS for oncoming trolleys before crossing by car, bike or walking.
- 5 At trolley stations, stand at a safe distance away from the tracks while waiting for a trolley or when a trolley is approaching until trolley comes to a complete stop.
- 6 NEVER STOP or park your car, bike, motorcycle or wheelchair on trolley tracks.
- 7 Pay attention when you are near trolley tracks: look for the trolley and listen for bells and warning horns. Pedestrians must yield to trolley.
- 8 Report any suspicious behavior, unsafe conditions or unattended packages to the trolley operator or supervisor.
- 9 STAY ALERT. Be aware of your surroundings and the people around you.
- 10 When standing on a trolley, always hold onto the railing while the trolley is in motion and do not lean on the doors.
- 11 To prevent a tripping hazard, DO NOT extend your legs in the aisle or leave personal belongings in the aisles or seats.

Trolley Fares

Exact fare is required. Operators do not make change.

Trolley Passes

Daily and 3-Day passes may be purchased on-board from the trolley operator. All other passes can be purchased at the North End Terminal Customer Service Center, 444 N. Main Street.

* MATA ID REQUIRED. Seniors and people with disabilities must have a valid MATA ID to receive a pass at a reduced price. Two forms of identification must be presented to obtain ID at MATA's Customer Service Center. (A Medicare card is a valid form of identification.)

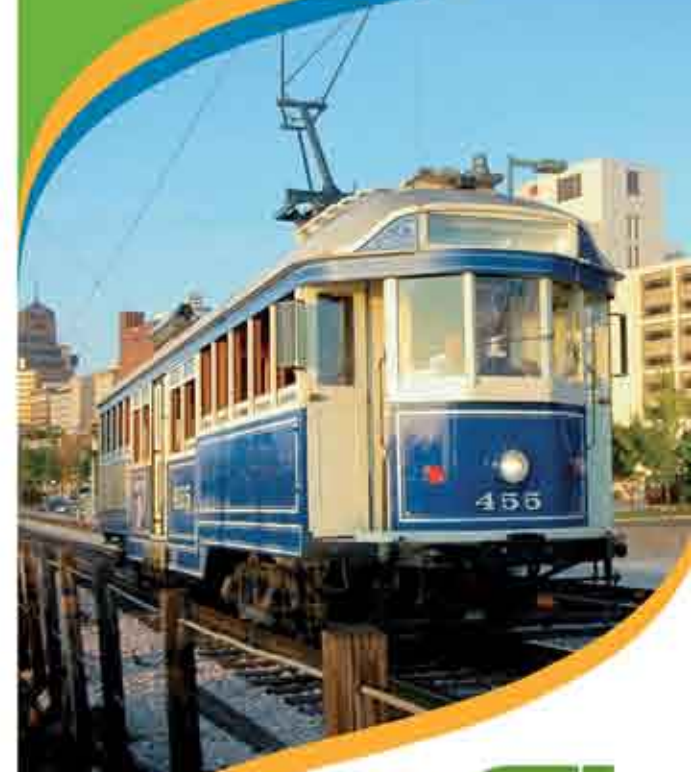
MATA Pass Policy
