MATA Announces Admin Offices Closed on Good Friday

No Changes to Service Operations

MEMPHIS, Tenn. – The Memphis Area Transit Authority (MATA) administrative offices will be closed on Friday, April 10 in observance of the Good Friday holiday.

As a reminder:

- Reduced levels of service will continue until further notice. For information about fixed routes, visit matatransit.com and click on the Maps and Schedules tab.
- MATAplus service will continue to operate from 4:30 a.m.-6:30 p.m.
- The Main Street Trolley rail line will continue to operate from 6:45 a.m.-8:30 p.m., the Riverfront Trolley line will operate from 10:30 a.m.-6 p.m. and the Madison Trolley line will operate from 6:45 a.m.-6 p.m.
- Fare is free on all MATA vehicles until Thursday, April 30.
- Due to COVID-19 social distancing restrictions, the lobbies at the William Hudson, Airways and American Way Transit Centers will continue to be closed until further notice. However, customer service counters at each Transit Center will be open from 7:30 a.m.-4 p.m. should customers need assistance. *Note: Only three customers will be allowed at a time into each Transit Center to transact business due to COVID-19 social distancing restrictions.*
- The MATA Call Center will be open from 6 a.m.-6 p.m. at 901. 274.MATA (6282).
- All live calls to MATAplus Reservations at 901.722.7171 (prompt #2) will be answered from 8 a.m.-4 p.m.
