MATA Plans to Host Two Meetings This Saturday at Mt. Pisgah MB Church to Discuss New Transit Option

MEMPHIS, Tenn. – The Memphis Area Transit Authority (MATA) will host two meetings on Saturday, April 24 at Mt. Pisgah Missionary Baptist Church (Family Ministry Center) located at 3636 Weaver Road from **10-11:30 a.m. and 1-2:30 p.m.** to discuss a new transit option for residents who live in Boxtown and surrounding neighborhoods.

The new service will allow residents to reserve by phone or phone app door-to-door transportation within a specific zone of the city. The purpose of the meetings is to familiarize residents with the new service and offer an opportunity to ask questions about the service scheduled to begin later this year.
