During his time there, Harris helped implement initiatives to foster customer service while overseeing the agency's fixed route, paratransit, maintenance and safety, and security departments.

"Ted brings a wealth of public transportation experience that will benefit our organization as we continue to focus our energies on improving the level of service delivered to all of our customers throughout our community," Rosenfeld said.

Harris also served previously as Vice President of Operations for MV Transportation in Fairfax County, Virginia; as Strategic Operations, Health and Safety Manager for King County Metro in Seattle; and in numerous positions for the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority in Washington, D.C.

"With plans to implement a next generation fare collection system, a new Transit Vision that will create a data-driven future bus transit network aimed at helping improve bus service, a new bus rapid transit line and additional customer-focused initiatives, this is an exciting period of growth at MATA," Harris said.

A graduate of the University of Waterloo in Waterloo, Canada, Harris holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Urban and Regional Planning. He is also a graduate of Leadership APTA, which is a senior and executive leadership program offered by the American Public Transportation Association.
