






Total ridership increase of 3.9% in FY23/Q3 compared to FY22/Q3






ROUTE RIDERSHIP RANKINGS






RIDERSHIP BY MODE






READY! RIDERSHIP by ZONE















March 2023 MEAN DISTANCE BETWEEN FAILURE






CUSTOMER FEEDBACK by MODE


FY2023 Financial Results Month-of-February 2023






FY2023 Financial Results Month-of-February 2023

Passenger Fares covering Jul-Feb of \$1.3M are \$137k favorable to budget. Year-To-Date Fixed Route was favorable to budget by \$120k, MATA+ was favorable to budget by \$28k, and Trolley was <\$11k> unfavorable to budget.






FY2023 Financial Results Month-of-March 2023

Passenger Fares covering Jul-Mar of \$1.34M are \$146k favorable to budget. Year-To-Date Fixed Route was favorable to budget by \$121k, MATA+ was favorable to budget by \$32k, and Trolley was <\$7k> unfavorable to budget.
