

Labor Needs By Category (November 2022)






TOTAL RIDERSHIP (November)






ROUTE RIDERSHIP RANKINGS (November 2022)






RIDERSHIP BY MODE (November 2022)










FLEET MAINTENANCE (November) Mean Distance Between Failure
