The Groove Shuttle, a pilot commuter shuttle running between Mud Island and the Medical District, operated by the Memphis Area Transportation Authority and the Memphis Medical District Collaborative will operate its final service on December 31, 2020.

A new on-demand system will begin in early 2021. This new service will allow riders to request the shuttle to pick them up at certain stops using an app or phone reservation. More details and information about the service will be announced in early 2021.

For current Groove riders, MMDC has you covered. We will provide transportation support for essential workers who are currently using Groove to get to and from the Medical District during the interim period between the January 1, 2021 and the beginning of the new Groove system.
